Down Under London to Brighton Run now open to vehicles at least 100 years old.

As the number of veteran vehicles entered has reduced each year, the organisers of the Down Under London to Brighton Run have changed the rules to enable vehicles at least 100 years old to participate on equal terms with the veterans.

If you own an eligible vehicle, we would be pleased to receive an Entry Form from you. We would also be grateful if you would pass this good news on to any people you may know who own, or are interested in, these vehicles.

By avoiding traffic bottlenecks and difficult intersections and the like, the Run is designed especially for older vehicles. Marshals are stationed along the route to direct participants without them having to consult any maps or directories.

The following summary may also be useful when considering the Run.

SUNDAY 29th OCTOBER 2023

From 9.00 am:

Arrive at London Road, Mile End South to socialise, prepare vehicles for the start; and to receive instructions.

At 10.00 am:

The "Lord Mayor of London" sends the vehicles on their way to Glandore for Morning Tea.

At 11.15am:

Participants head off for Brighton where the "Mayor of Brighton" awaits their arrival and inspects the subsequent display.

At approximately 1.00 pm:

Medallions are presented and entrants are free to leave.
